

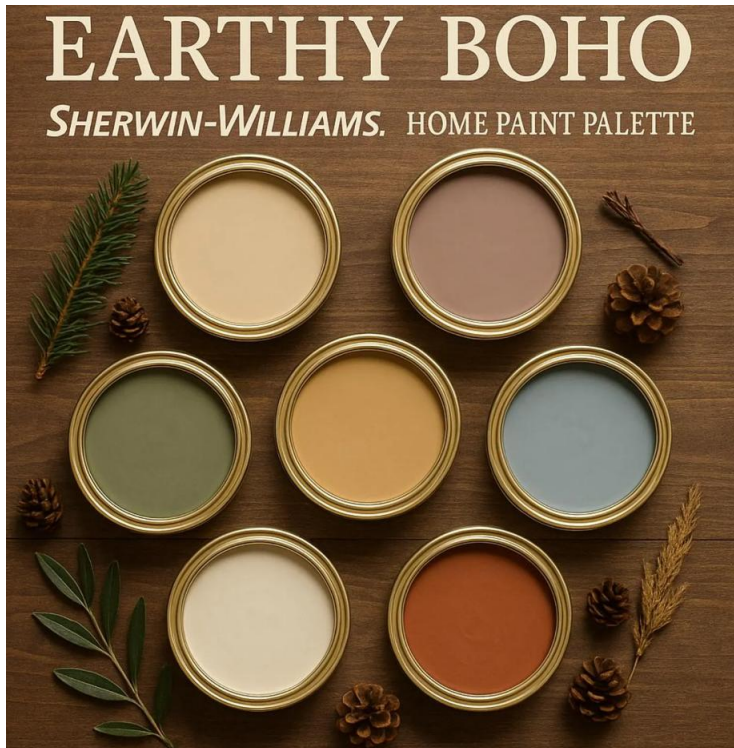
PAINT, COLOR AND DÉCOR POLICY

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to maintain a cohesive, welcoming, and professional visual identity throughout the school. Consistent use of approved colors and décor supports our brand, creates a calm and inviting environment for students, and reinforces our commitment to high-quality learning spaces.

1. Approved Colors

All painting, wall finishes, and decorative elements must adhere to the approved school color palette. Exact **Sherwin Williams** paint colors and codes provided and must be used for any repainting or renovation projects.



- SW 9541- White Walls throughout
- SW 2812- Green Locker and Doors
- SW 6241- Blue Doors
- SW 9153- Purple Doors
- SW 0012- Yellow Doors

Finish: **Satin Finish** for easy cleaning and durability.

*Door colors should be randomly rotated throughout and where lockers are, Willow leaf should not be used on the doors.

2. Classroom & Hallway Display Boards

- Teachers' décor and backing paper for display boards should only use colors from the approved palette or very close to those colors (natural tones).
- Overall mood should be **calm, natural, and inviting**. Avoid overly bright or neon tones that do not align with the school's aesthetic.

3. Décor Guidelines

- **Preferred Materials:** Incorporate natural textures such as **plants, wood accents, wicker baskets, and neutral fabrics**.
- **Lighting:** Use warm-toned lighting where possible to enhance a welcoming atmosphere.
- **Furniture & Carpets:** When replacing or adding furniture, choose wood or wood-look finishes over metal or plastic whenever feasible.
- **Plants:** Both live and high-quality artificial plants are encouraged in classrooms and common spaces to promote a natural and calming environment.
- **Consistency:** Seasonal or thematic décor is welcome but should still use the approved color palette as the base.

4. Compliance & Maintenance

- Any repainting, redecorating, or major furniture changes must be approved by school administration to ensure alignment with this policy.
- Staff are encouraged to report any worn or damaged painted surfaces for maintenance.
